The Education and Water Monitoring Action Group (EWAG) invites you and your class to take part in its new series of **free** training courses *Green Actions, Blue Future*.

You are welcome to register in as many courses as you wish, but as they are complementary, we recommend that you take the full series for a more comprehensive educational experience.
